At last we had some rain! We should not have to water for at least a week. We brought 100 stakes, courtesy of Mary Kerr, and stacked them by the trailer. Nic and I patrolled the Fleming Creek trail for Junior, with no result. Pat went looking for birds, while Nic and I loaded up for our last bout of trail-grooming of the season.

At the RL we saw a GBH take off from the near shore, while Pat saw a Nuthatch and some Blue Jays at the feeder. Nic and I groomed the last 100 m of trail, taking us from the RSF out to the river. As we did so, Pat showed up, looking for new plants along the riverbank. Then we went to Plot #5, hoping to finish it off. Of course, we didn't. (See list below.)

We took a break up on the HB while Pat told us via WT that she was heading back to the trailer. I took a close look at some of the Bitternuts on the HB, wondering if they had much of a future there. Most of the trees I examined had been brought to the brink by the drought or else had a bad case of crown gall.

By the time we got back to the trailer, the temperature, which had been dropping slowly all afternoon, now stood at 14 degrees C. Junior had still failed to show up at the trailer, so we had a little lunch. Pat reported finding a Ground Cherry (S) growing in the thick veg along the river right beside the entrance to the RSF. She also showed us an interesting minnow she had found, recently dead, near the rapids below the bridge on Fleming Creek. (S)

We left reluctantly after 7 pm, with no Junior in sight.
