Purpose: planting trees

Fleming Creek was again low enough to see the rapids clearly. There was “garbage everywhere” on site, so I cleaned up what I could. I brought in some trees from our home nursery: 1 WP (3’) 2 WA (5’ & 2’) 1IW (4’); I planted the Wild Plum, small White Ash and the Ironwood in the RZ, and I planted the larger White Ash up by the gate to add to the slowly-growing little “forest” I have started up there.

Note: Met Paul van Vaerenburgh of the West Elgin Roads Dept. He stated that they would be installing a berm along the side of the Fleming Line “one of these days.”
