While Brian got the remaining trees ready, I filled the tray feeders and too a load of straw down to the old hollow log on the 2BT, stuffing it and covering one end with a well-secured tarp. I then sprinkled some kibble around the log at the other end (where there is a small entrance) and even put some inside the log, so that whoever eats it will get the idea that it's hollow. Personally I think it's a great den site - but what do I know?

Brian did all the planting today: 2 WO along road above trailer,

1 WO along border with HBF2 WO in middle of regen zone1 RB (River Birch) inside the Hole

1 RB at (upper) RL

We then filled the two deer feeders with corn and went around the TRT, clearing branches and fallen BN trunks. As we went I laid down a small pile of kibble at each bench. We cleared 5 logs off the trail, with just 4 (stepovers) left to be cleared at leisure.
