Keep your personal information secret. Always log out of the school network computers. This includes removing your USB drives. Before using the school network make sure all USB drives have been scanned for viruses,they could be potential carriers.



Never visit unsafe websites. They could potentially be full of computer viruses that could effect your computer and the school network. Dont be fooled by phishing. You can compromise other UWO accounts. Report phishing emails to phishing@uwo.ca



If your device is lost, always change your password before your private information can be accessed. Seek campus police for lost items. Secure your computer by downloading Anti-virus software, Anti-spyware, and Anti-Malware.
