Keeping your computer up to date!

It is important to update your computer's software in order to download the latest security patches for your operating system!



Avoiding scam-links and spam-links!

Avoid viruses that can be spread via e-mail or instant messaging by avoiding clicking random links. For example, if you receive a message/e-mail out of the blue with nothing but a link, DO NOT click it!



Regularly scanning your computer for malware!

You should regularly scan your computer with your anti-virus software. By doing so, your anti-virus stays up-to-date and your computer virus-free! (MalwareBytes is a great virus scanning software)

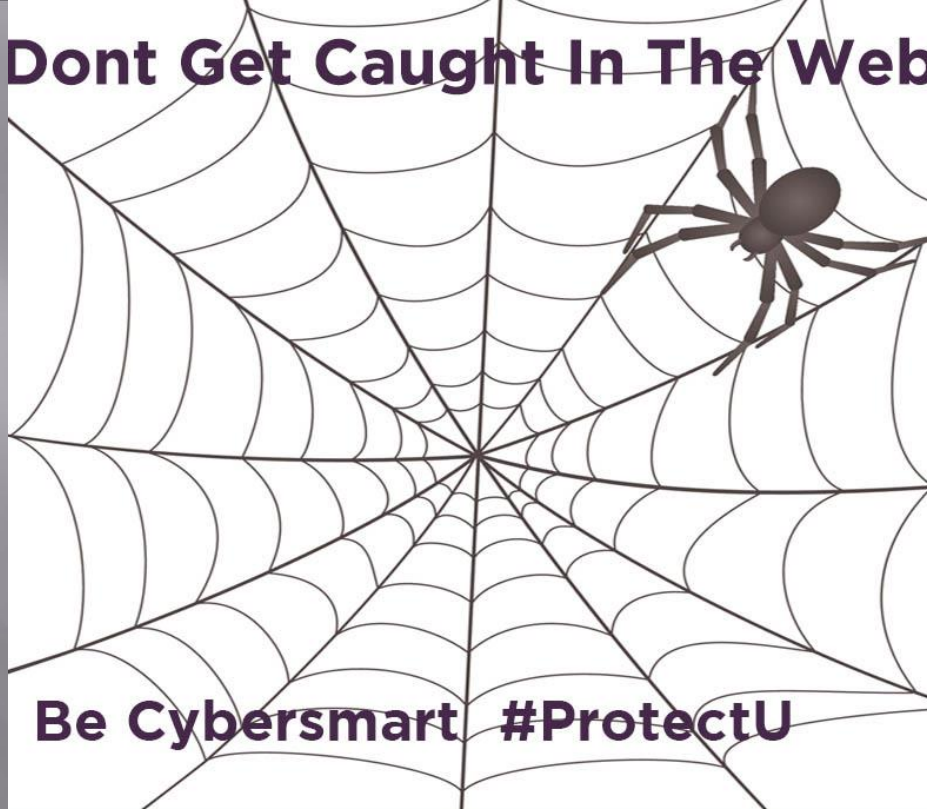

PROTECT YOUR CYBER SECURITY:

- 1) Make your password strong and unique.
- 2) If you lose your device, report it to campus police and change your passwords.
- 3) Never give anyone your password, student number, or user-name.

PROTECT WESTERN'S CYBER SECURITY:

- 1) Use an antivirus often. An unnoticed virus could easily spread accross the Western network.
- 2) Never click on emails asking for a username or password. A phisher could use your UWO account to gain access to others'.
- 3) Tell your friends to protect their own cyber security and teach them how to prevent cyber attacks.

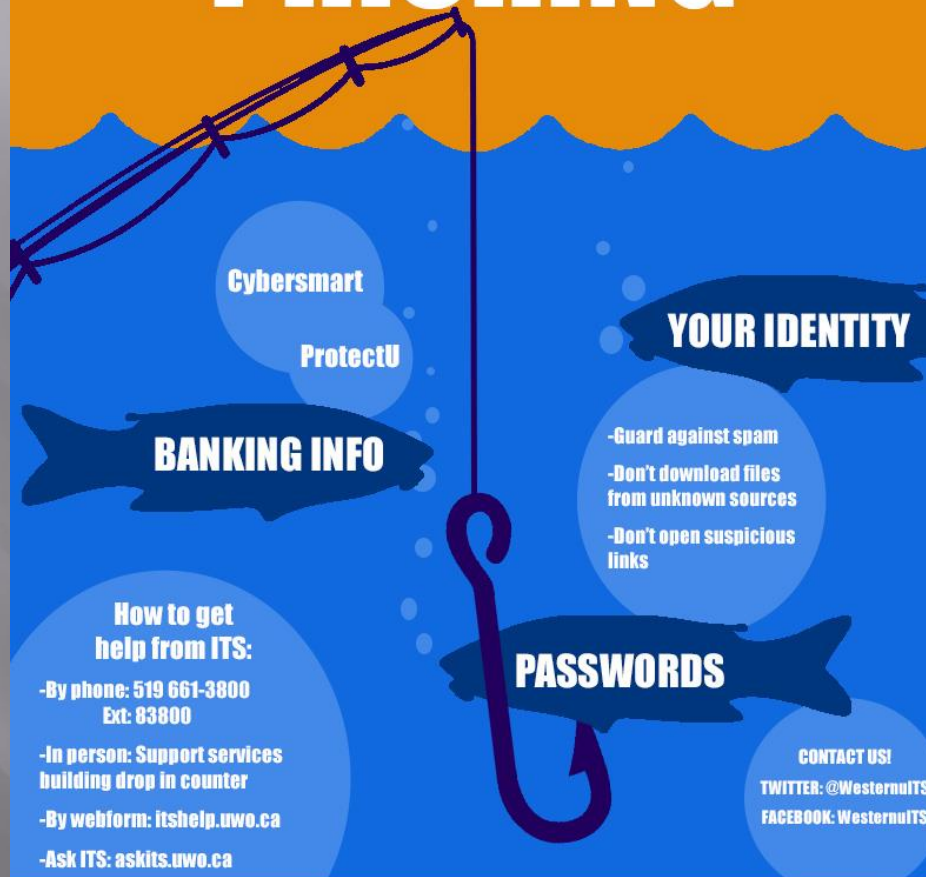

HERE ARE...

6 WAYS TO PROTECT YOURSELF

- 1.** Ensure you have strong passwords, antivirus and antispyware software, consistent security updates, a firewalled router with Wi-Fi Protected Access (WPA) enabled, if it is wireless, encryption and backup.
- 2.** Turn your system off when it is not in use. Your machine will be less of a target for break-in attempts, and less valuable as a 'robot' machine in a cracker's collection of compromised hosts.
- 3.** Backup important files to a removable medium (portable hard drive, usb key, CD/DVC, etc.). Make frequent and necessary backups and archive more than just one copy.

YOUR CAMPUS

- 4.** We are all one connected community. If your machine gets viruses on it and you connect to the network, it can spread. Please use antivirus software on a regular basis.
- 5.** Help protect our online community by reporting any phishing emails or scams to the proper channels.

WE ARE MUSTANGS NOT CYBER BULLIES

- the more students who stand up against cyber bullying can help put an end to it
- watch what you and others post; report the hate and spread the Western love
- do not retaliate; rather save the evidence and reach out for help

PROTECT YOUR IDENTITY

- do not post personal information on the internet (bank account numbers, social insurance number, or student number)
- your profile should not have your address, phone number or schedule
- use privacy settings and contact ITS if your account has been compromised

THE LURKING FACE OF ONLINE HOOKUPS?

- protect your private information and request to meet face-to-face
- when meeting in person, inform friends or family where you are going
- creeping can be okay: search social media to see if they are real (look for tags, friends or family photos, etc.)

PERMANENT POSTS

- nothing is temporary: almost everything you post or say is permanent
- watch out for what others post about you; this may affect future career prospects

PASSWORD PROTIPS

- use different usernames and passwords for different accounts
- combine letters, characters and numbers
- safeguard and change passwords regularly

AVOID PHISHING ATTACKS

- delete emails from unknown senders and never follow unfamiliar links to websites
- look for an urgent message, spelling mistakes and bad formatting
