WE ARE MUSTANGS NOT CYBER BULLIES

- the more students who stand up against cyber bullying can help put an end to it

- watch what you and others post report the hate and spread the Western love

 do not retaliate; rather save the evidence and reach out for help

PROTECT YOUR IDENTITY

- do not post personal information on the internet (bank account numbers, social insurance number, or student number)
- your profile should not have your address, phone number or schedule
- use privacy settings and contact ITS if your account has been compromised

THE LURKING FACE OF ONLINE HOOKUPS?

- protect your private information and request to meet face-to-face
- when meeting in person, inform friends or family where you are going
- creeping can be okay: search social media to see if they are real (look for tags, friends or family photos, etc.)

PERMANENT POSTS

- nothing is temporary: almost everything you post or say is permanent
- watch out for what others post about you; this may affect future career prospects

PASSWORD PROTIPS

- use different usernames and passwords for different accounts
- combine letters, characters and numbers - safeguard and change passwords - regularity

AVOID PHISHING ATTACKS

- delete emails from unknown senders and never follow unfamiliar links to websites
- look for an urgent message, spelling mistakes and bad formatting
- email phishing@uwo.ca or contact ITS
