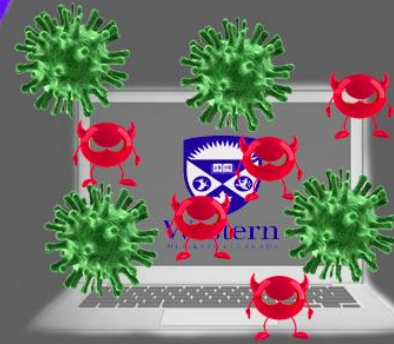

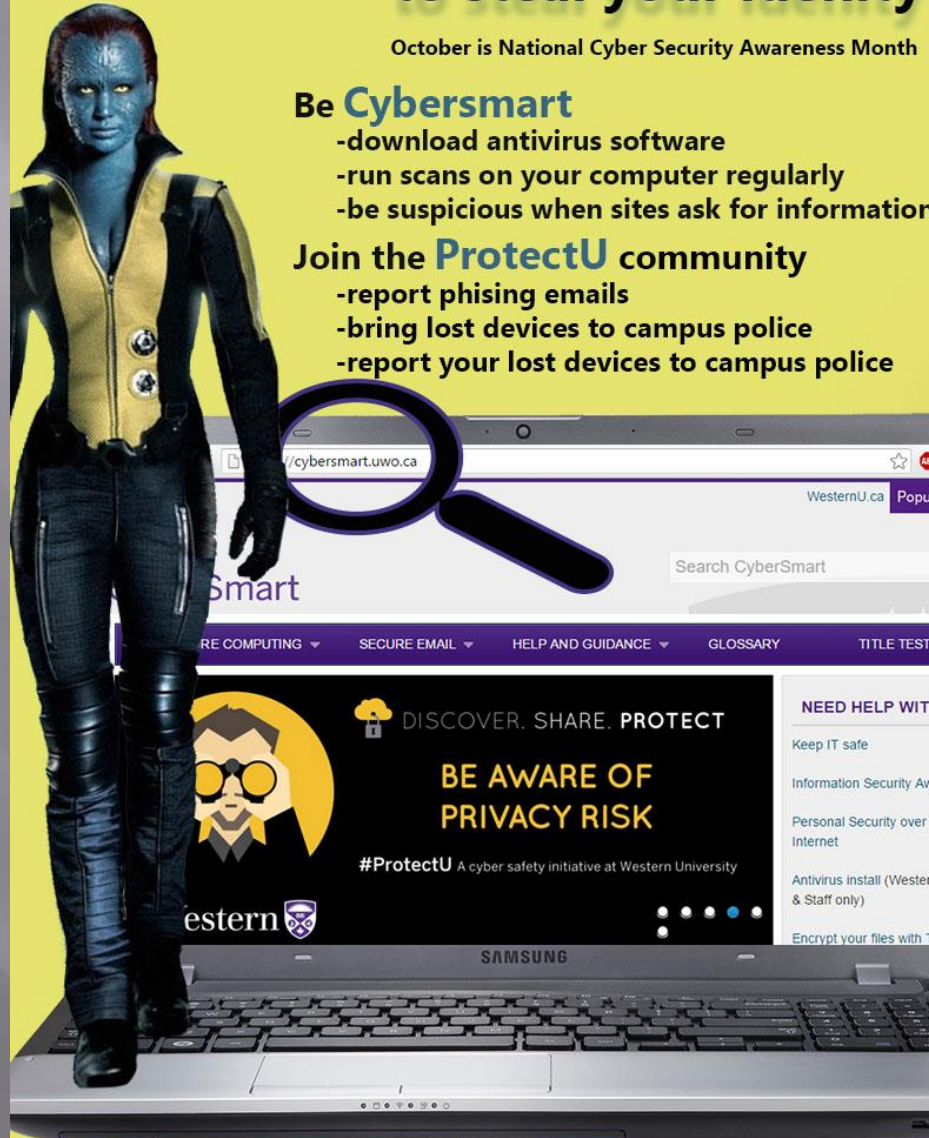

✓ protect your cyber security

- 1) Don't reveal personal details to strangers or just-met "friends".
- 2) Turn on cookie notices in your Web browser, and/or use cookie management software or infomediaries.
- 3) Realize you may be monitored at work, avoid sending highlypersonal e-mail to mailing lists, and keep sensitive files on your home computer.



✓ protect Western's cyber security

- 1) Implementing strong passwords is the easiest thing you can do to strengthen western's security.
- 2) Restrict software and set up administrative rights so that nothing can be installed on western's computers without authorization.
- 3) Making sure your computer is "properly patched and updated" is a necessary step towards being fully protected.

VIRUSES AND PHISHING

Protecting yourself is an important step to protecting Western. As one of our new round of posters says, we are all one connected community. If your machine gets viruses on it and you connect it to our network, it could spread. If your email gets phished, then they can use a UWO account to send other phishing emails to more UWO accounts. People are more likely to click something if it came from a UWO account.

DON'T REUSE PASSWORDS

Avoid reusing the same password for different accounts. This makes multiple accounts vulnerable if your password is discovered.

Other things that help protect the community are simple things like reporting phishing emails to the proper channels so that we can post them to make other aware (phishing@uwo.ca), if you find a lost device bring it in to the Campus Police, if you happen to lose your device report that to the Campus Police and make sure to change your password right away so that nobody else who has the device can use your credentials if they have been cached.

BE CAREFUL OF FREE PROGRAMS

Avoid downloading free software online unless you're certain it's from a reliable company. Many free programs are just a cover for adware and spyware. Much like viruses, adware and spyware may spread through our network.

THINK BEFORE SHARING

Sharing photos can be a great way to connect with friends and family, but they can also make you vulnerable. Be sure you crop photos that show information people could use to find you.

KEEP VIRUS SOFTWARE UP TO DATE

Install virus protection software and a firewall. Check for updates regularly.

CYBERSMART

How to protect your cyber security?

- 1 Be sure to install or activate antivirus defender in your computer. They can alert you before your device gets viruses!
- 2 Be careful to those pop-ups when you visit unfamiliar sites. Most of the time they are spams.
- 3 Do not share your personal information especially your bank account and credit card information when you are not sure whether the website is safe or not.

How to protect Western's cyber security?

- 1 Report spam emails or other websites that threaten to the university internet to the ITS.
- 2 Do not share your uwo account or gaul account to anyone you don't know. They might use your account to send spam email to your friends!
- 3 Do not download software from unidentified sources.

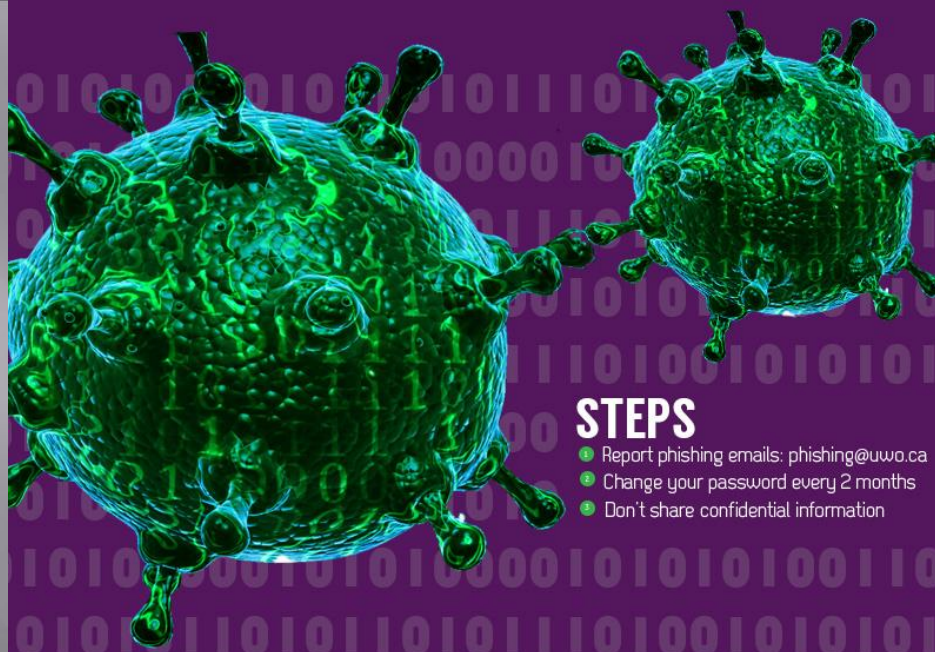
