VIRUSES AND PHISHING

Protecting yourself is an important step to protecting Western. As one of our new round of posters says, we are all one connected community. If your machine gets viruses on it and you connect it to our network, it could spread. If your email gets phished, then they can use a UWO account to send other phishing emails to more UWO accounts. People are more likely to click something if it came from a UWO account.

DON'T REUSE PASSWORDS Avoid reusing the same password for different accounts, This makes multiple accounts vulnerable if your password is discovered.

REPORTING AND
MAKING AWAR

Other things that help protect the community are simple things like reporting phishing emails to the proper channels so that we can post them to make other aware (phishing@unoc.a), if you find a lost device bring it in to the Campus Police, if you happen to lose your device report that to the Campus Police and make sure to change your password right away so that nobody else who has the device can use your credentials if they have been cached.

DE CARFUI OF FREI PROGRAMS Avoid downloading free software online unless you're certain it's from a reliable company. Many free programs are just a cover for adware and spyware. Much like viruses, adware and spyware may spread through our network.

THINK BEFORE

Sharing photos can be a great way to connect with friends and family, but they can also make you vulnerable. Be sure you crop photos that show information people could use to find you.

SOFTWARE UP TO DATE Install virus protection software and a firewall. Check for updates regularly.
