The Globalink Partnership Award provides \$15,000 for collaborative research between international for-profit companies and interns and faculty supervisors from Canadian universities.

Students travel to the company's country and conduct a research project on-site, with supervision from Canadian faculty.

Participating universities can strengthen existing international research collaborations and connect with colleagues and companies around the world.

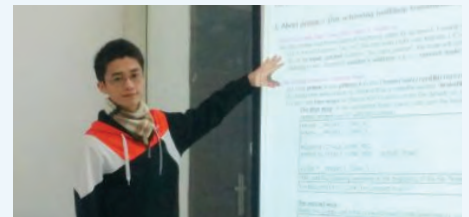
Who is eligible?

- At Mitacs full and associate partner universities:
 - Master's and PhD students (Canadians, permanent residents, or international students)
 - Professors who are eligible to hold Tri-Council funding
- International for-profit companies in all countries except the United States

The Globalink Partnership Award is flexible and fast

- Applications accepted anytime
- Peer review completed in six weeks
- Projects last four to six months
- Research can form part of student's thesis or dissertation
- Students are not company employees
